There were two training sessions 9 am to 12 pm and from 12 pm to 3 pm. These training sessions have already been organised for this coming winter starting in May 2014 and finishing in September 2014. Bowls Tasmania South has sent notices out to every southern bowls club informing them of these training sessions - so come along and improve your game, it is open to everybody from beginners to Division 1 players.

The southern junior boys and girls also had training sessions over the winter and summer month conducted by the southern junior manager Tom O'Brien and I.

On behalf of the coaches that assisted with the training, I would like to thank the Beltana Bowls Club for opening their club on these Sundays and making it available for coaching sessions and allowing members from other bowls clubs to come and use their synthetic green at no cost.

Members of the Southern Coaches Committee and I were invited to several bowls clubs to run coaching sessions this past season. Our southern coaches are more than happy to travel to any bowls club that needs help in running or organising bowls coaching sessions. If any other clubs would like to organise a coaching day all they have to do is contact the Southern coaches' panel or myself.

If your bowls club does not have an official bowls coach then we need to talk to your committee and arrange coaches for your club. Every bowls club in the south should have at least one female and one male coach in their bowls club. SOUTHERN UMPIRES' PANEL REPORT

The BTS Umpires Panel met on seven occasions in the past year and dealt with a wide variety of issues. In early October 2013 the Panel was advised by Bowls Tasmania to put on hold all new umpire and reaccreditation training courses until further notice. This was a result of a new umpiring structure to be introduced by Bowls Australia and the necessity to have presenters/assessors certified (a requirement of Australian Sports Commission). The Coaches Panel has been dealing with this for several seasons. Hopefully umpires will have a smoother transition to the new accreditation requirements once suitable personnel are put in place. Before receiving this direction the Panel completed outstanding reaccreditations of a small number of Level 1 umpires. The Panel also conducted a Level 2 course in September 2013 resulting in 5 umpires successfully reaccrediting and 1 new Level 2 umpire accredited. With the restrictions imposed the 2013-14 season has been very difficult for the Panel especially when endeavouring to maintain the high standards of training set in previous seasons.

In late October 2013 the Panel conducted a very successful umpire's forum where information was shared and many questions were discussed.

Max Barry resigned from his position as chair of the State Umpires Committee and Suzi Rogers accepted an invitation to fill the position. Trevor Govey continued as the BTS umpires representative. Both Suzi and Trevor resigned from the committee when BT decided to change the role of the committee. At this point in time the Committee has no members as the representatives from BTN and BTNW are understood to have also resigned.

Five BTS Umpires were invited to officiate at the National Sides Championships held at South Burnie Bowls Club in April 2014. The event was a great experience for those who officiated.

Max Barry resigned from our panel at the start of the year after a long and successful period of service to BTS umpires. The Panel wishes to recognise Max for his dedicated contribution over many years.

Once again representatives from the panel worked closely with BTS in updating the Conditions of Play and Side Captain's Guide prior to commencement of the season.

Currently there are 108 accredited umpires, 13 at Level 2 and 95 at level 1, a net reduction of 3. The Panel takes this opportunity to thank the former umpires for their past contributions.

Once again this season, where possible, we used our Level 2 umpires in supervisory and mentoring roles with Level 1 umpires for Southern and State events and have found that it is beneficial in increasing experience for the umpires.

The Panel thanks all its umpires for officiating in Pennant and Championship games. A special thank you also to our dedicated, hardworking panel members for the time and effort they gave to ensuring all BTS umpires maintain a high standard when officiating at all levels of the game.

MEN'S SELECTION REPORT

Bowls Tasmania changed the format of Statewide Pennant this season - the State team was not included which meant that regions had all their players to choose from. To prevent a bye the host region was required to field a second side with all points won by the second side added to the host region's scores. In addition each region was required to select at least three under 25 players in their side.

The first two rounds of Statewide Pennant were held in Hobart on 27 October 2013 and resulted in a win by the South team against the North West in the morning and a loss to the North in the afternoon.

Rounds 3 and 4 were played in Launceston on 24 November 2013. An unexpected 8-shot loss to the North's second team in the morning was turned around in the afternoon with a close 4-shot win over North's first team due to an outstanding 17-shot win by Cameron Tegg's rink over Mark Strochnetter.

The final two rounds were played at South Burnie on 2 March 2014. An ordinary performance in the morning resulted in an all-rinks 24-shot loss to North-West, however, the team performed better in the afternoon to record a 9-shot win over North-West's second team.

Final points were North West 64, North 62 and South 42.

Recognition of deceased members: All members stood for a short period of silence in recognition of those members who had passed away during the preceding year.

Affiliation Fees: Tony Fulton moved that affiliation fees for adult members be increased by \$3.00, that no changes be made to junior affiliation fees (\$30.00), that the registration fee of \$50.00 per team remain unchanged and that no changes be made to entry fees for BTS Championships (\$8.00).

The AGM was then closed at 2.20pm and President Trevor Quilliam invited members to participate in the post meeting discussion.

Matters discussed at post meeting discussion:

Non-Gender Specific Pennant:

In answer to a question from Bernard Knight, the President advised that no response had been received from Bowls Tasmania on the decision of Bowls Tasmania South not to implement the directions from Bowls Tasmania in regard to non-gender specific pennant. Bernard is strongly in favour of non-gender specific pennant and urged Bowls Tasmania South to reconsider its decision.

Phil Hobbs wanted to know what is being done to increase member participation. He suggested that the move to non-gender specific would have helped remove current restrictions and increase participation particularly from social bowlers. He also suggested that increased flexibility with registrations for each Club's lowest team – perhaps by striking a team registration fee rather than individual member registration fees - may help attract new bowlers.

Chris Lee spoke in support of non-gender specific bowls and outlined the positives of its introduction. He urged Clubs and the Bowls Tasmania South Board to push for its introduction for Saturday Pennant. John Hadley suggested that the introduction of a Women's Saturday Pennant is a retrograde step. The introduction of non-gender specific pennant is the way to go.

Doug Cole spoke in support of the current Mixed Saturday Pennant and thinks that the North and North West should also run a Mixed Pennant competition on Saturday's. Doug further suggested that and women State players should be able to play in Men's Saturday Pennant.

New Website

Robert Davies sought more information on the new website being introduced by Bowls Australia. Tony Fulton advised that Bowls Tasmania has to pay an annual fee for this but he doesn't believe any costs have to be met by Club's, however, no further information is available at present.

Juniors Report:

Tom O'Brien recommended that a report on Junior activities should be included in future Annual Reports.

Tom O'Brien urged Bowls Tasmania South to push for the introduction of a State Under 25 Competition. Every other State has an Under 25 Squad.

Southern Bowls Tasmania Directors:

Bernard Knight queried why Bowls Tasmania South had appointed two new Bowls Tasmania Directors which he thought was contrary to the Bowls Tasmania Constitution. The Secretary, Rob McGuire, advised that Bowls Tasmania South, at the request of Bowls Tasmania, had sought expressions of interest from Clubs for both positions. As only one nomination was received for each position there was no election necessary and both were appointed. If an election had been necessary it would have been Clubs who voted on who they wanted as their Director – Bowls Tasmania South would have had no say in the appointments.

Saturday Pennant:

In answer to a question from John Hadley, Trevor Quilliam advised that Men's Division One will remain at 16-a-side and that all Divisions except the lowest would remain at 10 teams. Bowls Tasmania South will consider reducing the number of players in each side for the lowest divisions if that will help Clubs.

Trevor Quilliam thanked Beltana for the use of their Club for the meeting. He also thanked everyone for attending and wished them all the best for the coming season.
