SOUTHERN UMPIRES' PANEL REPORT

This past year has been a difficult one with many changes taking place including the restructure of training and accreditation of umpires, the introduction of an updated version of the Laws of Bowls and several Panel members resigning. A smaller Panel met as necessary during the past year and dealt with the changes and a variety of other issues.

At the start of the year the longest serving Panel Member Shirley Knight resigned. Shirley has been a valuable member of the Panel and her input has been missed. She has actively continued officiating at many events. Thank you, Shirley for your devotion to umpiring and administration over many years.

Other members who resigned include Suzie Rogers, Trevor Govey and Keith Bailey who all moved to the mainland. Each of them provided excellent service on the Panel in various roles and the loss of their expertise has been felt this year. Thank you, Suzie, Trevor and Keith for the valuable work done on behalf of all BTS Umpires.

The BTS Board has agreed that the Panel should continue with a smaller numbers of members and the three remaining Panel members Helen Ducker, Leonie Price and Tony Kerrison were appointed to continue. The BTS Board has requested a full reviewed of the structure and duties of the Panel which will be considered before the start of next season.

Following a meeting of World Bowls several amendments were made to The Laws of Sport of Bowls and Crystal Mark 3rd Edition was issued and became effective on 1 January 2015. Bowls Australia updated and added new Domestic Regulations also effective on 1 January 2015.

The new Officiating (Umpiring) Structure commenced on 1 January 2015 and there are now three levels for officiating - Markers, Measurers and Umpires. Ross Bannister is the BTS Assessor/Presenter for the new Officiating Structure. He has completed several very successful courses resulting in a number of accredited Markers and Measures and a number of umpire reaccreditations. The Umpires Panel has assisted Ross with the sessions he has presented.

Three experienced umpires from BTS were invited to attend a World Bowls International Accreditation Course conducted by Mark Cowan, the Bowls Australia ITO Accreditation Officer. To obtain accreditation each candidate has to achieve a very high mark in each aspect including questions on laws, marking a singles game and a series of difficult measures. Only one of the BTS Umpires was successful, with the other two being invited to attend some practice sessions and undertake the Accreditation again next year. Congratulations to Leonie Price who successfully accredited as an ITO.

During the year a number of Umpires and Markers have had the opportunity to officiate at Southern and State events and these opportunities have been very beneficial in increasing their experience in officiating.

The panel thanks all its umpires for officiating in Pennant and Championship games. A special thank you also to our dedicated, hardworking Panel members for the time and effort they gave to ensuring all BTS umpires maintain a high standard when officiating at all levels of the game,

MEN'S SELECTION REPORT

Three rounds of the Veolia State Wide Challenge were conducted during the 2014-15 season with additional sponsorship monies available from Veolia for each winner of the Men, Women, Juniors and Seniors (Over 60s). An extra incentive was the introduction of an overall winner with money and shield attached.

As in the previous season each region hosted a round of the Veolia State Wide Challenge although the Junior competition was centralised in Launceston. Host regions were required to field a second side and each team was obliged to include at least three players under 25 years of age. The Men's selectors were Tony Hack, Alex Stanelos and Grant Allford

The first round of the Men's was conducted on the new synthetic surface at the Buckingham Bowls Club on 19 October 2014 in difficult conditions. The South had mixed fortunes on the day with a pleasing performance from the Number 2 side and this resulted in some changes to the side going forward to South Burnie on 16 November 2014 where, despite playing on a quick green in windy conditions, the side performed well against the strong North West combinations beating the North West 2 side comfortably and narrowly losing to North West1.

The third and final round of the Veolia State Wide Challenge was conducted at North Launceston on 8 February 2015 again with mixed results, beating the North 2 side and losing to North 1 with one rink soundly beaten. Conditions were again tricky on a very fast green.

Overall points were: North West 79; South 45 and North 44.

While the Men and the Juniors ran second, the Women, Senior Men and Senior Women won their SWC sections resulting in an overall win for the South.

Congratulations to all players who represented the South and thank you to managers, coaches and selectors for their time and effort. Thanks also to BTS for recognising the achievements of the representative sides by hosting a party at Buckingham at season end.
