Minutes of the BTS Board Meeting held at 4.30pm at North Hobart Bowls Club on Monday 25 October 2021

Welcome

President Peter Kirby opened the meeting at 4.25pm.

<u>Minutes</u>

Acceptance of previous minutes

Moved: Paul Matthews, Seconded: Ailsa Milburn that the minutes of the meeting held on 18 September 2021 be confirmed. CARRIED

Action items from previous minutes

BTS Tribunal Members. No further nominations from female bowlers have been received.

Board members uniform. The President planned to work through a design with the board but time did not permit. Held over until the next meeting.

RCC matters - Selectors playing in SWC teams. The minutes of the recent RCC meeting were circulated to the board, and briefly summarised by the President.

Trans-gender players. Moved: Michael Andersch, seconded: Leonie Price, that the BTS Gender Identity Inclusion Policy be accepted until such time as Bowls Tasmania publish a state-wide policy, at which time it will be reviewed. **CARRIED**

ACTION: SECRETARY

Flat Fee Membership Model. The President asked that we stop using "fixed fee" and instead use "flat fee" to refer to this proposal. The President noted his discussions with Bowls SA and Bowls WA on their fee models; he will call a meeting of the Finance Committee to begin formulating a model for Bowls Tasmania South.

ACTION: PRESIDENT

Prize money for pennant winners in 2020-21. The Treasurer advised the board that this had been resolved. Prize money for pennant ceased with the loss of our major sponsorship several years ago.

Review of Secretary's duties. The Secretary tabled his analysis of the "Duties of the Secretary" document for board consideration. It not being urgent, discussion was held over to the next meeting.

Publicity Officer. Connor Munnings is receiving reports from Saturday Premier Division and Thursday Division 1 teams and submitting reports to the Mercury. Moved: Paul Matthews, seconded: Geoff Price, that Connor's appointment be confirmed.

CARRIED

Facebook administration. The Secretary informed the board of his ongoing difficulties in transferring administrator rights. Rob McGuire continues as the BTS Facebook group administrator for now. **ACTION: SECRETARY**

Public Officer. The Secretary advised the board that he was now the public officer for the association, and this fact has been registered with the Department of Justice (Consumer, Building and Occupational Service).

Sponsorship - Derwent Eye Care. Not forthcoming.

Working with Vulnerable People. The board resolved to manage this registration in BowlsLink. No further action is required by the Secretary.

BTS Policy/Guidelines. The Secretary noted the publication of the following documents to the website, and the distribution of this policy to clubs.

- Constitution (Sep 2021)
- Coronavirus and lawn bowls policy
- Conditions of Play
- Guidelines for Side Captains
- Nominated Surfaces

Vacancy on BTS Match Committee. Moved: Ross Bannister, seconded: Paul Hoddy, that the appointment of Rosie Geeves to the Match Committee be confirmed.

CARRIED

Vacancies – Southern Sides Selectors, Coaches, Managers. Moved: Paul Matthews, seconded: Paul Hoddy that the appointment of Garry Francis as a selector for the Men's Over 60s team be confirmed.

CARRIED

The board resolved to re-issue the call for expressions of interest to fill vacancies.

ACTION: SECRETARY

Mixed Pairs Championship. Ross Bannister advised the board that we would have to hold the competition at an indoor centre as it would not be possible otherwise to fit the event into the calendar. Moved: Ross Bannister, seconded: Matthew Gregg that we send out forms for an Open Mixed Pairs competition (3-bowls/15 ends) in February (entries to close on 20 Jan 2022).

ACTION: SECRETARY

Status of Division 7. Paul Hoddy reiterated to the board that Division 7 should be referred to as "Challenger League" as the intent was that Saturday Division 6 would be the lowest division and be able to hold more than 10 teams. Moved: Ross Bannister, seconded: Paul Hoddy that we provide clubs with a clear explanation of the intent in order to revisit this issue at the next Delegates meeting. **CARRIED**

ACTION: Match Committee and BTS Conditions of Play Committee

Action items from Special General Meeting minutes

Changes to the Constitution. The Secretary noted the publication of this document to the website, and the lodgement of the amended constitution with the Department of Justice (Consumer, Building and Occupational Service).

Action items from Delegates minutes

Advise BTAS of "no state finals" decision. Notwithstanding the resolution passed at the Delegates meeting, Ross Bannister noted that Bowls TAS invites pennant divisional winners to play in state pennant finals and Bowls TAS set the conditions of play. Since the resolution was not binding on any club, the board resolved to advise the RCC meeting rather than Bowls TAS that "clubs have indicated their intention to not accept invitations to play in state pennant finals while the conditions of play for this event favours the minority of sides."

ACTION: SECRETARY

Correspondence

The Secretary circulated a listing to the board (676 emails received, 447 emails sent) prior to the meeting. Moved: Paul Matthews, Seconded: Ailsa Milburn that outwards correspondence be endorsed and inwards correspondence be accepted.

CARRIED

Business arising from correspondence

Snap Three-Day Lockdown. The board noted that Saturday Pennant (Round 1) was cancelled, this Board Meeting was postponed till 25 Oct 2021, and advice regarding Bowls Activity and the wearing of masks was issued to clubs.

Lease Room at Berriedale Centre. This matter is yet to be dealt with.

ACTION: SECRETARY

Bulk registration and payment of fees. The Secretary advised the Board that all registrations had been received. The Treasurer advised the board that total fees received to date were \$140,928 (including GST), or \$128,116.32 (excluding GST) and that we would be paying \$96,000 of this to Bowls TAS on 1 November 2021.

BTS Fours Championships entries. The Secretary noted that 48 teams across four events were entered. An administrative error requires re-issuing of the draws which will be done today. **ACTION: SECRETARY**

Ladies Tuesday pennant games (Round 1). The Secretary noted that advice regarding green preparations and closures was formulated by the Board out of session and circulated to clubs.

Nominated Surface: The Secretary noted that club nominations had been circulated and published to the website.

COVID-19 Vaccinations and Bowls. The Board noted this advice from Bowls TAS.

Live streaming Premier Division Game. The Board discussed this proposal by Bowls TAS who would do all the work if a game is identified. The board resolved to ask Kingborough and Sandy Bay if they would agree to move their Premier division clash (a grand final replay) to Friday night (12 Nov). **ACTION: PRESIDENT**

Incident Report. A report of poor behaviour by a member was received and considered by the Board. No action will be taken at this time, but the misbehaviour was noted for possible future reference.

Southern Tops. The Board resolved to order a supply of larger tops (2 x 7XL. 2 x 6XL and 2 x 5XL). **ACTION: SECRETARY**

Uniform delays. The Board ratified temporary uniform exemptions granted to Buckingham, Franklin and Ouse as a result of delays in delivery of new uniform orders.

Shared positions. The Board ratified the decisions to approve position sharing at North Hobart, Howrah and Kingborough.

Letters of support. The Board noted letters in support of grant applications sent to Huonville, Sorell, and Tasman.

Bruny – Play and Stay Promotion. The Board endorsed the inclusion of the Bruny "Play and Stay" promotion on the Bruny Island page of the handbook.

New club uniform (Glenorchy City). The Board approved Glenorchy City's proposed new uniform tops.

Howrah Women's Division 4 pennant plaque. The Board resolved to re-issue the Howrah Women's Division 4 pennant plaque after fixing the type and add another name at Howrah's request on a shared cost (50/50) basis.

Ladies Division 4 game (Orford/Sandy Bay). The Board acknowledged the error in the roster that caused this confusion and noted that the matter had been resolved.

Men's Registration for Thursday pennant (Sorell). The board approved three Men's Division 4 players (Peter Bell, Phil Lidbury and Dennis Mansfield) to play as opposite gender substitutes for Ladies Division 4.

Use of Streamline Microphone (Taroona). The Board approved the use of a streamline microphone for a hearing-impaired player (to listen to instructions from the skip) on the proviso that it was only used when the player was in possession of the mat.

Trophies 2021-22. The Board resolved to pre-order trophies, plaques, medallions, etc, in order to ensure supply. **ACTION: SECRETARY**

Reports

Finance: Moved: Deb Jeffrey, Seconded: Paul Hoddy that the financial report presented to the Board (see summary at Appendix 1) be accepted. **CARRIED**

Match Committee: Moved: Ross Bannister, Seconded: Geoff Price that the report presented at Appendix 2 be accepted.

CARRIED

Coaches Panel: Ross Bannister advised the Board that he was planning some coaching courses in the near future at the request of clubs. He also noted that some of the certifications (cards) have been received after a 19 month delay and he was expecting cards for nine more courses soon.

Selectors: Nothing to report.

Officiating Panel: Moved: Michael Andersch, Seconded: Leonie Price that the Panel's report presented at Appendix 3 be accepted. **CARRIED**

Clearances: The Board resolved to endorse the clearances received to date (see Appendix 4). The Secretary asked if paper clearances were required, and if fees would be imposed if all clearances were done by clubs via BowlsLink. The Board resolved to discuss this matter at the next Annual General Meeting. **ACTION: SECRETARY**

Ongoing Matters

Uniforms for Bowling Arm Tasmania 2021 Program. Geoff Price advised the Board that he attended a state-wide meeting recently and that meeting decided on 10 reps per district. The Board resolved to order additional Bowls South tops (8 x Men, 2 x Women).

ACTION: SECRETARY

BTS Strategic Plan 2019-23 (President). The Secretary will circulate the Strategic Plan to the Board and publish it to the website. **ACTION: SECRETARY**

General Business

Reviews/changes to policy documents. The Board resolved that changes to any BTS documents must be made on a copy of the master document obtained from the Secretary to ensure everyone is working from the same/most current version.

BTS Documents for Review. Consideration of the following documents was held over to the next meeting. Feedback is to be sent to the Secretary (for consolidation).

- Strategic Plan
- Uniform Policy (Rewritten)
- Guidelines for Minutes of Meetings (New)
- Duties of the Secretary (Proposed)

BTS Seal. The Secretary asked (as Public Officer) if a seal was required. Answer: No.

BTS Postal Address. The Secretary advised the Board that we now had a new postal address – PO Box 232, Rosny Park, 7018 – and that he would be closing the old Glenorchy post office box in the coming week.

New Business

Washed out rounds. Moved: Paul Hoddy, seconded: Geoff Price that the players named to play in the first two Saturday rounds (one cancelled due to the three-day lockdown, one cancelled due to inclement weather) be counted as having played those games for the purposes of determining a player's grade. **CARRIED**

Conditions of Play anomaly. An anomaly in the BTS Conditions of Play was discovered as a result of "live testing" rule 3.25 following Saturday's washout. As a consequence of this, the Board resolved that, effective immediately, rule 3.25 would be amended by removing clause 3.25 (b) leaving only two conditions under which a change of surface can be made.

ACTION: SECRETARY

Upcoming Bowls TAS events. The Board was made aware of an expression of interest by Brad Johns to provide advertising, promotion and Live-streaming for the upcoming Bowls TAS events to be held in the South. **ACTION: Matt Gregg**

Hosting of Bowls TAS events. The Board noted that Beltana, Claremont and Rosny Park had nominated to host Bowls TAS events. This information will be passed to Bowls TAS.

ACTION: SECRETARY

Free STP training for Club Treasurers. The Treasurer sought board approval to offer free Single-Touch Payroll training to club treasurers. The board endorsed this kind offer.

ACTION: TREASURER

BowlsLink and BTS Championships. The question of entering BTS championships via BowlsLink (instead of via paper forms) was raised. This matter is ongoing.

BowlsLink and Vaccinations. The BowlsLink Administrator (Paul Hoddy) advised the Board that clubs/members can register their vaccination status in BowlsLink, and this should be encouraged as consideration is being given to a "no jab/no play" policy by some states.

ACTION: SECRETARY

BowlsLink and Live Scoring. The BowlsLink Administrator advised the Board that the Live Scoring App would be released this week.

Next Meeting

The next meeting will be held on Monday 22 November 2022 at 4.30pm at North Hobart Bowls Club.
